

I. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION / RULES OF USE FOR THE CLIMBING PARK PURKERSDORF

Each visitor/participant (hereinafter referred to as TN) must read through the following conditions of participation and rules of use and agree to them by signing. In the case of minors, the parent or legal guardian must read through the conditions of participation and discuss them with the minor before the latter is allowed to use the courses.

- (1) The use of the climbing park is associated with risks and is at the participant's own risk. Incorrect handling of the equipment, incorrect use of the safety equipment or failure to comply with the instructions given in the safety briefing can result in serious injury or even death.
- (2) The participant acknowledges that injuries such as skin abrasions or the like are to be expected when walking the courses. Depending on the season, clothing may also be soiled by resin on the trees.
- (3) The climbing park is open to visitors who are 110 cm tall or taller and who do not suffer from an illness or a mental or physical impairment that could pose a risk to their own safety or that of other participants. Children under 14 years of age may only be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- (4) Persons who are under the influence of alcohol or drugs are not permitted to enter the climbing park.
- (5) Pregnant women are expressly prohibited from climbing.
- (6) When entering the climbing park, no objects may be carried that pose a risk to the safety of the participant or other participants (jewelry, mobile phones, cameras, etc.).
- (7) Long hair must be tied up.
- (8) The rented equipment may not be taken off at any time during the hike and must be used expressly as instructed by the trainers. It is not transferable to third parties and must be returned to the trainer at the end of the climbing park visit.
- (9) Each participant must take part in the entire safety training including the completion of the introductory course before entering the course.* All instructions given by the trainer are binding. In the event of non-compliance or infringement of these, the operator/owner of the climbing park Purkersdorf accepts no liability for any damage caused. Furthermore, the operator/owner reserves the right to exclude offending participants from the climbing park.
- (10) Each individual station may only be used by one participant at a time. A maximum of 3 participants may be on the platforms/podiums at the same time.
- (11) Smoking when wearing a harness and/or in close proximity of the equipment as well as in the terrain/forest is strictly prohibited.
- (12) The operator/owner is liable for personal injury within the framework of the statutory provisions. Damage caused by the participant himself/herself (e.g. through carelessness, such as bumping into things, tripping, slipping, etc.) is the responsibility of the respective participant or the respective parent/legal guardian. The operator/owner is only liable for property damage and financial losses in the event of intent or negligence on the part of the person entrusted with the performance or guidance.
- (13) The participant gives his/her consent that any photos or recordings taken by the operator/owner during his/her activity, on which the participant can be seen, may be used for advertising purposes of the climbing park Purkersdorf - however, only insofar as it is not possible to draw any conclusions from them as to the identity of the participant or the data provided by the participant.
- (14) The operator/owner reserves the right to suspend operation for safety-related reasons (e.g. fire, storm, thunderstorm, etc.). In this case, there will be no refund of the membership fee.
- (15) Course 7 is only to be entered after consultation with the guides, otherwise a one-off fee of 25 EUR is to be paid in the event of rescue from the course by one of our guides.

* (9): For participants who have already taken part in the climbing park Purkersdorf AND in a safety training course during the current season, there is the possibility to participate only in a safety check (see point III).
